New Adult Class: The Gospel of Luke

Next Sunday, January 28, Care Groups will begin a new series in the Gospel of Luke. Our main question as we work through Luke's Gospel is, 'Who then is this?' Our hope through asking this question is that we can immerse ourselves in the story-world of Luke's narrative and characters and explore, wonder about, and discover alongside them the identity of this Jesus. Who do the characters think Jesus is? How did they come to that knowledge? Who does Luke present Jesus to be? What might this mean for our coming to know Jesus? What might this mean for our witnessing to others about who Jesus is?

Our first class, a combined introductory class, will cover Luke 1-3.
