



Crop Hunger Walk Our outreach ministry is sponsoring a team to participate in the annual Durham Crop Hunger Walk on Saturday, April 10 – Sunday, April 18. Hunger Walk Donations are used to support hunger alleviation programs around the world. 75% of the funds collected goes to Church World Service, an international relief agency, and the remaining 25% stays right here in Durham to support local relief programs such as the Food Bank of Central & Eastern NC, Open Table Ministries, Families Moving Forward, and Urban Ministries of Durham. This year's walk will be virtual so we are planning some great events and challenges to make it fun and exciting for the whole family. Join us as we help fight hunger both here in Durham and around the world. More details will come on how you can help support this awesome event.
