Guest Preacher Dennis Conner is a native North Carolinian, born in Winston-Salem. He received a degree in Bible from Lipscomb University in 1976. It was at Lipscomb that he met Terre Crosslin and they were married in June 1975. Dennis and Terre were married for 35 years before Terre finished her 11 ½ year journey with cancer on September 2, 2010. Dennis and Terre adopted their son, Nelson, in 1990 when he was 10 years old. On November 5, 2011, Dennis married Sherie Lutz, a dear friend of his and Terre's for 37 years. Sherie is retiring at the end of this school year after 40 years as a public school teacher in both North and South Carolina. Dennis served as the associate minister at the Warner's Chapel Church of Christ in Clemmons, NC from 1977-78. From 1979-March 2006 he was the preaching minister for the Yadkinville Church of Christ in Yadkinville, NC, and served as the preaching minister for the

Brooks Avenue Church of Christ in Raleigh from March 2006 until his retirement in January 2022. Dennis has served on the board of directors of Carolina Bible Camp and Retreat Center since 1982 and was a weekly Director for 34 years before retiring as the Week 6 Director in 2022. However, he and Sherie still volunteer at camp. Sherie and Dennis reside in Fort Mill, SC, and have five grandchildren whom they delight in.
