Welcome Brad Carter is in the US for the summer months, and we are fortunate to have him preach and lead the adult class for us on Sunday. His partner in life and ministry, Rachael, will also be joining him on this visit. They have three children who were raised in Eswatini (formerly Swaziland). Brad has served as president of African Christian College and lived on campus with his family for the past 13 years. He enjoys sharing stories of God at work in Africa -- especially to partners in ministry like Cole Mill Road -- and is passionate about helping others follow King Jesus. He studied Bible and ministry at ACU (undergrad and grad degrees) and has his Doctorate in Educational Leadership from Lamar University. Before moving to Africa, Brad worked in student development and teaching at ACU, doing community development work as a minister and later a nonprofit executive director, and consulted with nonprofit boards and leaders.
