# **Upcoming Adult Ed Classes** Two new classes begin on October 12:

<u>1 Corinthians</u> Join Carl Holladay and Ben Fike for a simple, thoughtful study of Paul's first letter to the Corinthians. Together we'll work through the book week by week, listening deeply to what this letter has to say to the church today.

A Christian Response to 'The Anxious Generation' This 9-week class will discuss Jonathan Haidt's book "The Anxious Generation: How the Great Rewiring of Childhood is Causing an Epidemic of Mental Illness." The class will be co-taught each week by one of our CMR psychiatrists (John Beyer, Justin Gettings, Luke Smith) and a CMR parent (Laura Rash, Brenda Peterson). Though much of the focus will be on parenting issues related to technology, all members are welcome in this important discussion of the role technology plays in our lives and how we as Christians should respond and reflect.

Rise Against Hunger Team CMR will join Rise Against Hunger on Saturday, October 11 (10:00 AM–12:00 PM at Triangle Grace Church) to package meals for hungry children and families worldwide. We exceeded our goal, registering 33 volunteers and raising \$3,584!
