<u>1 Corinthians</u> Join Carl Holladay and Ben Fike in the Fellowship Hall Auditorium for a simple, thoughtful study of Paul's first letter to the Corinthians. Together we'll work through the book week by week, listening deeply to what this letter has to say to the church today.

<u>A Christian Response to 'The Anxious Generation'</u> This 9-week class will discuss Jonathan Haidt's book "The Anxious Generation: How the Great Rewiring of Childhood is Causing an Epidemic of Mental Illness." The class will be held in Room 9 of the Fellowship Hall, co-taught each week by one of our CMR psychiatrists (John Beyer, Justin Gettings, Luke Smith) and a CMR parent (Laura Rash, Brenda Peterson). Though much of the focus will be on parenting issues related to technology, all members are welcome in this important discussion of the role technology plays in our lives and how we as Christians should respond and reflect.
